Under 49 CFR Part 26.87, if NDOT or another party challenges the eligibility of your organization you will be notified in writing and given the opportunity to present your arguments against removal in an informal hearing. If after this hearing your certification is removed, you will have the opportunity to appeal that decision to the U.S. Department of Transportation.

NDOT reserves the right to withdraw this certification if at any time it is determined that it was knowingly obtained by false, misleading, or incorrect information. DBE/SBE certification is subject to review at any time. Your firm hereby consents to the examination of its books, records and documents by NDOT.

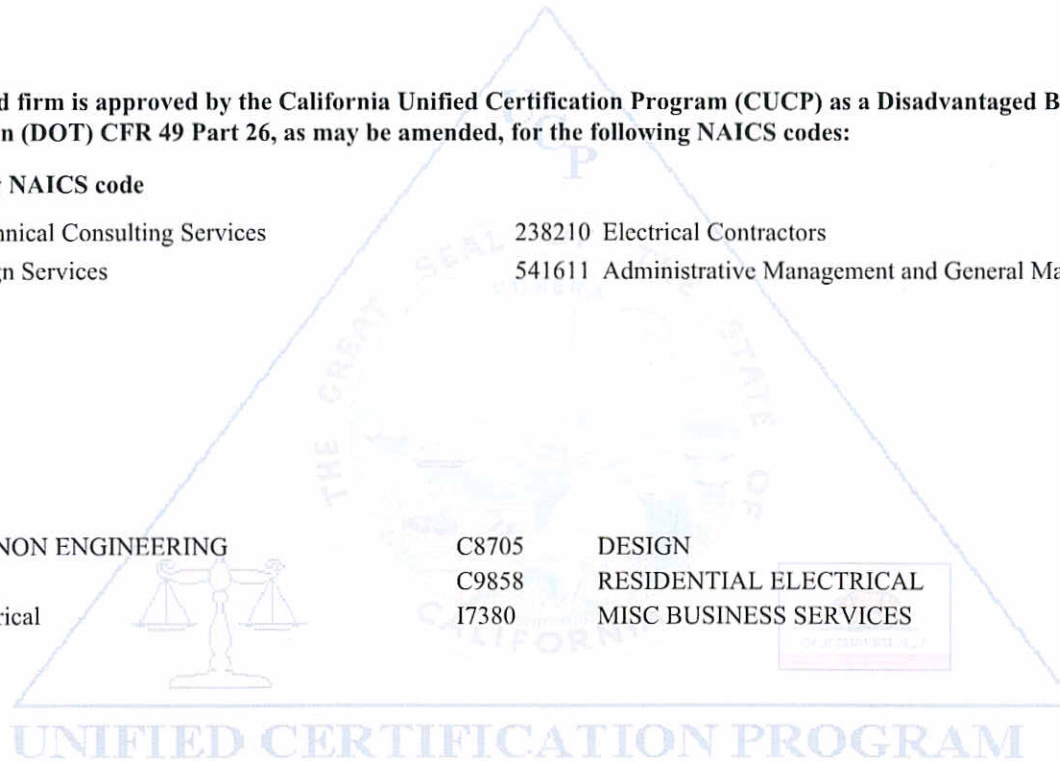
